1st Street Gate Reminders

Overall, the **No Badge-No Entry** process at the 1st Street gate has worked well. The majority of staff have their AbSSLC badge.

A few things that will help get you (and everyone else) through the gate faster:

- Have your badge ready and available to show. It's very help if you will actually roll you window down and have the badge out. Pointing at it on your mirror or flicking it up and down doesn't work.
- Many windows are too heavily tinted to see through. If you don't roll your window down, you will be asked to stop and do so to ensure your badge can be seen and verified.
- Gate staff must be able to match you and your badge. We have already had previous staff (using the badge that was not collected when they left) try to get into campus.
- You cannot have items in the back of your pickup – this also goes for your designated driver. This is not a new rule.
- Try not to act ugly or entitled.
 Everyone that comes in has to show their badge. Some staff act like it's a personal affront to them it's not. If you would like to work the gate, you can see for yourself!
